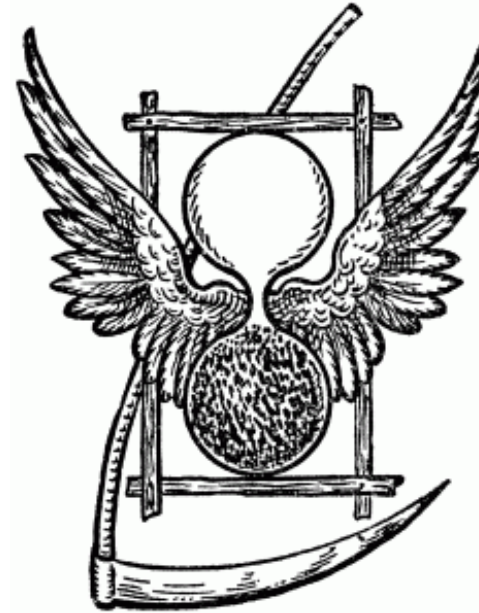
## CASUAL BBQ NIGHT
