We will open the Lodge at 6:00pm, followed by the banquet at 6:30pm, and resume labour at 7:30pm. I hope to see you all there.

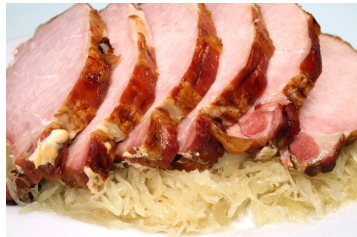

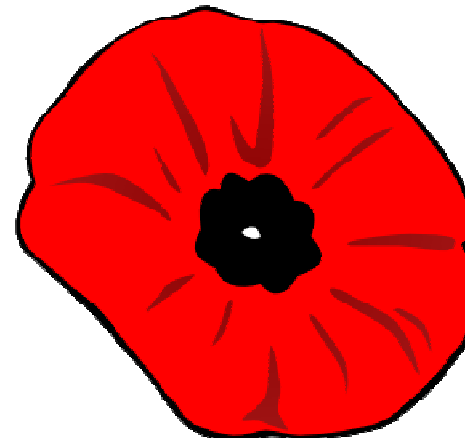
LEST WE FORGET
