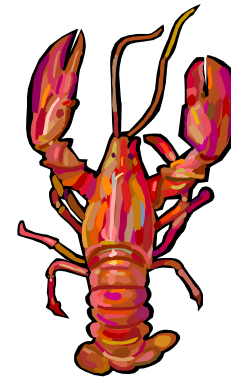
RANDOLPHE JOSEPH ARSENAULT
