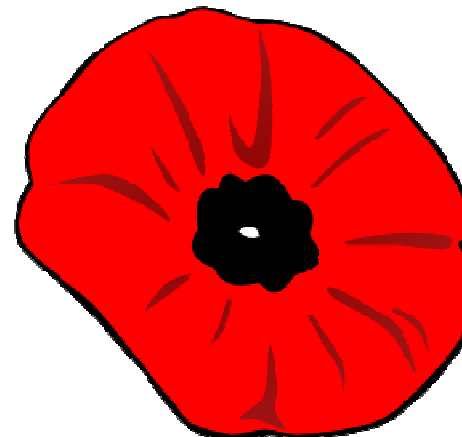
LEST WE FORGET
