ARTICLE VIII
Powers and Supremacy

Section 1

The YORK RITE COLLEGE OF NORTH AMERICA, subject of this Constitution , is the only source of authority in all matters pertaining to any organizations existing under or by virtue thereof.

Section 2

THE YORK RITE COLLEGE OF NORTH AMERICA has authority to grant Dispensations and Charters for the institution of York Rite Colleges and reserves the right expressly to annul, suspend, or revoke, for cause, any Dispensation or Charter issued by it.

Section 3

THE YORK RITE COLLEGE OF NORTH AMERICA has jurisdiction over all subjects of legislation and administration. It has appellate jurisdiction from the decisions of York Rite Colleges and the officers thereof. It has the power to make such laws for its own government and the government of York Rite Colleges as it shall find necessary and expedient. It may alter, amend , or repeal the same. It may reprimand, suspend, or expel any member from its own body or may direct the reprimand, suspension, or expulsion of any member of a York Rite College. It may fix the location and define the limits of each York Rite College, and it shall have the final decision in determining all matters or controversies between them.
